The Snake River Cutthroats are proud to present the 2024 Banquet / Auction. By hosting the banquet we hope to achieve multiple purposes, including an enjoyable dinner and a fun evening. Our primary objective is to raise funds that support education programs and our conservation projects to benefit the fisheries of eastern Idaho. Thanks to your support, the Cutthroats have contributed \$448,265, which was raised from past Expos, to conservation projects and education programs. Conservation projects have received the bulk of these funds, \$424,910, with over \$345,052 going to support Trout Unlimited's programs on the South Fork, tributaries of the South Fork, and the Blackfoot River. Other local conservation partners that have benefitted from Expo funds have included the Teton Regional Land Trust, ID Department of Fish & Game, Caribou-Targhee National Forest, Friends of the Teton River, Southeast Idaho Fly Fishers, the Henry's Fork Foundation and the South Fork Initiative. In a long-standing partnership with the Salmon National Forest, the Cutthroats have also contributed 30 years of sweat equity by working on the Salmon River tributaries.

The chapter also conducts many fly-fishing education programs and classes in fly tying, casting, rod building and we recently established a vibrant youth program. We need volunteers to help with these programs as well as a lot of other activities. These programs and projects provide a great way to meet like-minded people who share a love of fishing. So if you are interested, please keep an eye on our website for activities or contact a Snake River Cutthroat officer to share your interests.

We are pleased to have you with us here tonight and hope you enjoy a pleasant evening. Consider supporting our conservation and education efforts by purchasing raffle tickets, and bidding on live and silent auction items. The trout will love you for it and you will have the added satisfaction of knowing you are giving something back to the fisheries that have given so much to you.





<u>1. Match the Hatch – Cutthroat by Mark Susinno</u></u>

This limited edition print numbered 570 of 950, celebrates our native local cutthroat trout doing what we all spend the entire year waiting for - chasing salmon flies. A talented artist and fisherman from Maryland, Mark specializes in underwater depictions. His work has appeared in the Art of Angling Journal, Gray's Sporting Journal, Sporting Classics, Field & Stream, Sports Afield, Fishing World and Fly Fisherman. He notes, "I enjoy suggesting the sense of light and space of the shallow-water aquatic environment, but I also feel the need to present the fish themselves such that they are recognizable to the average fisherman, who is most familiar with how a fish looks when it is out of water." Don't miss this chance to take home a beautiful piece that will help you make it through to the next salmon fly hatch.

2. Main Snake Guided Trip

Steven has the honor of having tied for the legendary Buz Buszek Fly Shop in Visalia, California, which was "Fly Tying Central" for much of the fly fishing industry for decades around the middle of the twentieth century. Beyond his tying talent, he is also a very gracious teacher, willing to share his knowledge with other tiers. 22. Collectors Bamboo Rod by Ralph Moon


Ralph Moon was an accomplished bamboo rod maker and crafted many rods during his lifetime. He also generously shared his knowledge with other aspiring rod builders, building a legacy that lives on today in the creations of his apprentices. Ralph labeled this blond bamboo rod the "Firehole" and it is a 6ft 3-4 wt rod ideally suited for its namesake river. This rod features a down locking reel seat over beautiful wood and a quality cork grip. The rod was made by Ralph himself, originally purchased by Ed Thomas of Bozeman, Montana, who has donated it to the Snake River Cutthroats to share with another collector. Bamboo rods cast with a certain grace that seems linked to their heritage from a slower, more deliberate time. Modern, space-age graphite composite rods from today cast tight loops at bullet speeds, but tend to lack the quiet patience our sport once embodied. Don't miss this opportunity to own a hand crafted Ralph Moon fly rod, a collectors item from the golden age of fly fishing. The rod comes with the original handmade rod sock and metal case, all as a package that Ralph created.

23. WorldCast Anglers South Fork Canyon Overnight Trip

Enjoy a unique two day getaway on the South Fork of the Snake River with an expert guide from WorldCast Anglers. Spend your first day fishing the upper canyon chasing wiley cutties in the beautiful canyon setting. In the evening you will arrive at WorldCast's luxurious Cottonwood Camp where you will enjoy a mouth-watering meal prepared by their streamside camp chef.



Complementary wine and beer are stocked at camp and hors d'oeuvres will be waiting while the guide gets you acquainted with your own cozy and private wall tent complete with sleeping bags, cots, carpet, and wash towels. The next morning after a hearty breakfast you will enjoy the 16 mile float out of the canyon, fishing the many braided channels. 
25. 2024 Hyde Hybrid XL Low Profile
