The Snake River Cutthroats are proud to present the 2026 Banquet / Auction. By hosting the Banquet we hope to achieve multiple purposes, including an enjoyable dinner and a fun evening. Our primary objective is to raise funds that support education programs and our conservation projects to benefit the fisheries of Eastern Idaho. Thanks to your support at past Expo Banquets, the Cutthroats have contributed \$529,787 to conservation projects and education programs in our region. Conservation projects have received the bulk of these funds, with \$467,105 dedicated to Trout Unlimited's programs on the South Fork, tributaries of the South Fork, and the Blackfoot River. Other local conservation partners that have benefitted from Expo funds include the Teton Regional Land Trust, ID Department of Fish & Game, Caribou-Targhee National Forest, Friends of the Teton River, Southeast Idaho Fly Fishers, the Henry's Fork Foundation and the South Fork Initiative. In a long-standing, 30-year partnership with the Salmon National Forest, the Cutthroats have also contributed sweat equity to a multitude of projects on Salmon River tributaries.

The chapter also conducts many fly-fishing education programs and classes in fly tying, casting, trout in a classroom and supports a vibrant youth program. We need volunteers to help with these programs as well as a lot of other activities. These programs and projects provide a great way to meet like-minded people who share a love of fishing. So if you are interested, please keep an eye on our website for activities or contact a Snake River Cutthroat officer to join our efforts.

We are pleased to have you with us here tonight and hope you enjoy a pleasant evening. Consider supporting our conservation and education efforts by purchasing raffle tickets, and bidding on live and silent auction items. 



Satoshi is an artist with the vise and bobbin and his creations are truly amazing. He is a guide in the South Western Montana area and ties some amazing flies in the off season. Don't miss your change to take home a modern recreation of some absolutely beautiful and historic Atlantic Salmon Flies.

### **13. Cowboy Drifters Trip**

If you are looking to sample some of Wyoming’s blue ribbon trout fishing, this trip is for you. Located in Casper Wyoming, Cowboy Drifters will introduce you to the fabled North Platte River. They fish the infamous Grey Reef and Miracle mile sections, which are known for big, healthy rainbows, browns, and cutthroat — the type of trophies that keep anglers coming back year after year. With experienced guides, quality drift boats, and access to miles of productive water, they will help anglers of all skill levels experience what makes Wyoming fly fishing special. After an enjoyable day fishing you can kick back for the night in one of their comfy side cabins. Package is for TWO people and includes ONE day guided fishing with lunch and ONE night’s stay in a cabin. Booking dates are based upon availability, so plan ahead. Trip must be taken in the 2026 season.



### **14. Driftboat Accessory Upgrade**

Tired of your worn-out net, equipment rattling around your feet in the bottom of your boat, and a squished sandwich for lunch? This package will put you back into the high life with all the drift boat accessories you’ve always wished you had. The package includes a Yeti Tundra 45 hard Cooler, which is guaranteed to keep that sandwich and all of your favorite snacks and beverages cool, even on those hot scorcher days of August when a cool refreshment can be a lifesaver. Get rid of that old worn out aluminum net, and upgrade with a Fishpond Nomad El Jefe Grande big enough to land any fish. To help keep all your fishing gear organized, we are also including an Orvis waterproof boat bag. To help your back out when hoisting in that anchor we are including an easy pull pulley. And finally a solution to those pesky drain plugs that ALWAYS snag your line, a set of RGG No Snag drain plugs. Don’t miss this opportunity to upgrade all your drift boat accessories, hit the river in style and start enjoying the pampered life.

### **15. Minam Store Outfitters Trip**

This truly unique trip will provide you with a treasure trove of fun memories. Just over the border into Oregon a little northeast of La Grande lies a 40-mile roadless canyon, officially designated as a Wild and Scenic River Corridor that is formed by the Wallowa and Grande Ronde Rivers.. The area offers excellent blue ribbon trout fishing in June and July as well as great steelhead fishing in February and March, when daytime highs typically rise into the 50s. This trip is a float into the roadless section of the Wallowa River with an expert guide from Minam Store Outfitters who knows all of the secrets to entice trophy-sized rainbows to your fly and all of the holes where steelhead lie. At the end of the day, the shuttle also offers a very unique experience as you and all of the gear will be loaded up on a rail-capable vehicle and you will enjoy a scenic ride back up the canyon on the train rail seeing the beautiful scenery in reverse. Trip is for TWO anglers and must be taken by the end of March 2027, so you have your choice of fishing the trout or steelhead seasons.

Trip must be taken in the 2026 season.




## **19. Tying Update and Organization Kit**

## **22. Four Hosts / Four Trips**





### **24. Snake River Cutthroats Tree Sponsorship Paddle Raise**
